John baptizes Jesus 1:29-34

Jesus turns water into wine as his first miracle 2:3-11

Jesus drives out the moneychangers from the temple with a whip 2:13-21

Nicodemus asks about the two births 3:1-21

Jesus tells the Samaritan woman of the living water, and she agrees that he is the Messiah 4:5-42

Heals a nobleman's son who is at the point of death 4:46-54

Jesus heals a man, infirm for 38 years, at the pool of Bethesda 5:2-16

The Jews seek to kill Jesus because he declares that he is the Son of God 5:17-47

He feeds 5,000 with five loaves and two fish 6:5-13

The people desire to make Jesus a king 6:14-15

Jesus walks on water 6:16-21

Jesus says, "This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent." 6:28-29

Jesus declares that he is the bread of life 6:30-40

The Jews murmur at him 6:41-42

Jesus restates that he is the living bread 6:43-58

He scolds the disciples because some of them believe not and one is a devil 6:60-71

Jesus' brethren mock him 7:1-10

The people at a feast dispute Jesus' ability 7:12-13

No man lays hands on Jesus because his hour was not yet come 7:30

Again, no man lays hands on him 7:44

A woman caught in adultery is brought before him. She is not condemned 8:3-11

Jesus says, "I am the light of the world." 8:12

Again, no man lays hands on him 8:20

The Jews boast that they be of Abraham's seed and Jesus chastises them 8:33-58

He passes through the midst of an angry crowd 8:59

As he passes through, he heals a blind man with clay made of spittle 9:1-7

The Pharisees question the testimony of the man that was blind 9:8-11

Jesus declares that he is the door of the sheep and that he takes care of the sheep 10:1-18

There is a division among the Jews over the things Jesus says 10:19-21

The Jews ask Jesus if he truly is the Christ and he declares that he and the Father are one 10:24-38

He escapes out of their hands again 10:39-40

Lazarus is raised after being dead four days 11:1-46

The chief priests and Pharisees take council to kill Jesus 11:47-57

Six days before the Passover, Mary anoints the feet of Jesus for his burial 12:1-8

Jesus rides into Jerusalem sitting on an ass' colt, fulfilling things written of him 12:12-18

"Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die... He that loveth his life shall lose it; ..." 12:23-27

For the sake of the people, the Father speaks 12:28-30

Jesus declares that those who believe him believe the Father 12:44-50

The feast of the Passover 13:1-38

Satan enters into Judas 13:27-30

Jesus tells his disciples that he is the way, the truth and the life 14:6-7

He reproaches Philip for not believing that he and the Father are one 14:8-21

He tells the disciples of the promise of the Comforter 14:22-31

Jesus exhorts the disciples to keep his commandments and abide in him 15:1-27

Jesus prays for the apostles 17:1-26

Jesus goes to the garden 18:1

Judas betrays Jesus 18:2-5

Peter begins to deny him 18:15-18

Jesus is struck by one of the high priest's officers 18:19-23

Peter denies him twice more and the cock crows 18:25-27

Pilate questions Jesus and, finding no fault in him, tries to release him 18:28-40

Jesus is scourged, platted with a crown of thorns, mocked with a purple robe, and set before the people 19:1

Pilate tries again to release Jesus 19:6-15

Pilate delivers Jesus to the Jews to be crucified 19:16

Jesus is crucified 19:17

Jesus gives up the ghost 19:30

Jesus is pierced, but his bones are not broken 19:34

Joseph of Arimathea buries Jesus 19:38-42

Mary discovers that Jesus is resurrected and Peter and the other Mary see 20:1-7

Jesus appears to Mary 20:11-18

Jesus appears to the disciples 20:19-26

Thomas doubts that Jesus is risen 20:24-29

Jesus appears to Nicodemus 20:31

Jesus appears to his brethren 20:32

Jesus directs some of the disciples to go and catch fish to eat 21:1-14

Jesus reveals to Peter how he will die 21:15-19

In Acts it says Jesus is with them forty days and speaks of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God. Acts 1:3
